

Electric Rate Workshop
September 4, 2007

MidAmerican Energy Company held its third electric rate workshop on September 4, 2007, at the Des Moines Area Community College in Ankeny. The workshops are being held in compliance with the Iowa Utilities Board Order in Docket No. RPU-04-2 issued on June 19, 2006.

Eleven people attended the workshop representing the Office of Consumer Advocate, industrial and residential customers. MidAmerican Energy Company had thirteen employees in attendance.

A presentation by MidAmerican Energy Company on nonresidential rate design included cost-of-service review, goals and objectives for rate design, illustrative end-state rate design, and proposed rate classes. The rates presented at the meeting illustrated potential increases and decreases given a certain set of assumptions for the three pricing zones. Company representatives responded to workshop participant questions.

Donald E. Johnstone, Competitive Energy Dynamics, L. L. C., speaking on behalf of AGP, gave a presentation on Rate Considerations noting nine items of consideration. Information presented will be posted on MidAmerican's web site.

The fourth and final workshop will be held on October 2, 2007 at the Des Moines Area Community College in Ankeny beginning at 10 a.m. The subject of the workshop will be street and private area lighting. Presentations by workshop participants are welcomed.
