



Rider DRR – Demand Response Resource Service

Class of Service Rider DDR
Demand Response Resource Service

Available Available to any electric customer capable of providing at least 10 MW of Demand Response Resource (DRR) to the Company through no-notice physical load interruption.

The maximum DRR service available under this tariff for all customers is 50 MW.

Customers providing DRR under this rider must be able to reduce electric demand to

- Zero MW, or
- A level of MW reduction defined by agreement between Company and customer

This service will be available until MidAmerican ceases to be a Balancing Authority Area.

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Rider DRR – Demand Response Resource Service (Cont.)

Credit Monthly credit of \$4.00 per kW of DRR Capacity x DRR Capacity Factor

$$\text{DRR Capacity Factor} = \frac{\text{Billing Period Energy} - \text{Base Load Energy}}{\text{Annual Peak Demand} \times \text{Billing Period Hours}}$$

Where:

Billing Period Energy = Total metered energy during the billing period

Base Load Energy = Energy typically used when DRR capacity is not in operation as defined in the service agreement

Annual Peak Demand = Highest hourly peak demand recorded during the prior rolling 12-month period regardless of time of day recorded

Billing Period Hours = Total hours of the billing month adjusted for Daylight Savings Time

Interruption under this DRR service shall be independent of any other Curtailment Service under which the customer participates. For such customers participating in other Curtailment Services offered by the Company, reduction in power level under

- This DRR Service Shall not be considered as satisfying the requirements of the other Curtailment Services.
- Other Curtailment Services shall not be considered as satisfying the requirements of this DRR service.

No payment shall be made if the customer fails to interrupt or reduce service under the provisions of this DRR Rider and the terms of the service agreement.

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
