# KEEPING THE NIGHT SKY DARK WITH **ADLS**

People are liking what they see — or rather what they don't see — with the new aircraft detection lighting system (ADLS) at some of our wind farms.

The Federal Aviation Administration (FAA) requires wind farms to operate synchronized red flashing lights to warn pilots of nearby turbines in the airspace. With this new system, the red warning lights are only activated when the ADLS detects an aircraft within three nautical miles of a wind farm. But, the system turns the warning lights back off after the aircraft leaves the area — so the only light in the night sky is from the moon and the stars!

MidAmerican is continuing to ensure this new technology can fulfill its promise of improving the night sky. If proven successful, our aim is to bring these new systems to more of our wind communities across the state.
